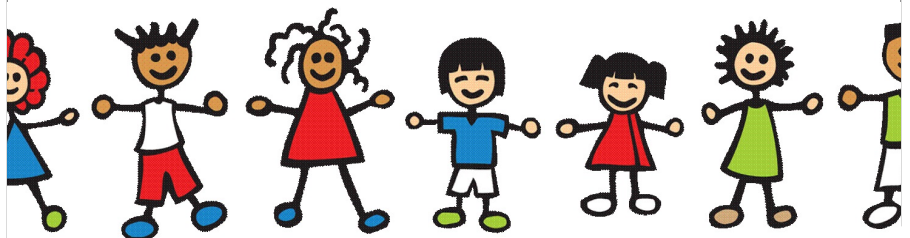

Volunteer Corner

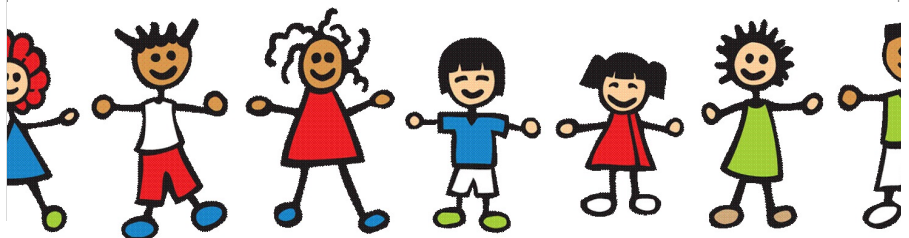
