- 14** **When Jesus saw this, he was indignant. He said to them, “Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these.**
- 15** Truly I tell you, anyone who will not receive the kingdom of God like a little child will never enter it.”
- 16** And he took the children in his arms, placed his hands on them and blessed them.

Jesus Feeds the Five Thousand

- 1 Some time after this, Jesus crossed to the far shore of the Sea of Galilee (that is, the Sea of Tiberias),
- 2 and a great crowd of people followed him because they saw the signs he had performed by healing the sick.
- 3 Then Jesus went up on a mountainside and sat down with his disciples.
- 4 The Jewish Passover Festival was near.
- 5 When Jesus looked up and saw a great crowd coming toward him, he said to Philip, "Where shall we buy bread for these people to eat?"
- 6 He asked this only to test him, for he already had in mind what he was going to do.
- 7 Philip answered him, "It would take more than half a year's wages to buy enough bread for each one to have a bite!"
- 8 Another of his disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, spoke up,
- 9 "Here is a boy with five small barley loaves and two small fish, but how far will they go among so many?"
- 10 Jesus said, "Have the people sit down." There was plenty of grass in that place, and they sat down (about five thousand men were there).
- 11 **Jesus then took the loaves, gave thanks, and distributed to those who were seated as much as they wanted. He did the same with the fish.**

Joseph Accepts Jesus as His Son

- 18** This is how the birth of Jesus the Messiah came about[a]: His mother Mary was pledged to be married to Joseph, but before they came together, she was found to be pregnant through the Holy Spirit.
- 19** Because Joseph her husband was faithful to the law, and yet did not want to expose her to public disgrace, he had in mind to divorce her quietly.
- 20** But after he had considered this, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, "Joseph son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife, because what is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit.
- 21 She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins."**
- 22** All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had said through the prophet:
- 23** "The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and they will call him Immanuel" (which means "God with us").
- 24** When Joseph woke up, he did what the angel of the Lord had commanded him and took Mary home as his wife.
- 25** But he did not consummate their marriage until she gave birth to a son. And he gave him the name Jesus.

Jesus Calms the Storm

- 35** That day when evening came, he said to his disciples, "Let us go over to the other side."
- 36** Leaving the crowd behind, they took him along, just as he was, in the boat. There were also other boats with him.
- 37** A furious squall came up, and the waves broke over the boat, so that it was nearly swamped.
- 38** Jesus was in the stern, sleeping on a cushion. The disciples woke him and said to him, "Teacher, don't you care if we drown?"
- 39** He got up, rebuked the wind and said to the waves, "Quiet! Be still!" Then the wind died down and it was completely calm.
- 40** He said to his disciples, "Why are you so afraid? Do you still have no faith?"
- 41** They were terrified and asked each other, "Who is this? Even the wind and the waves obey him!"

Zacchaeus the Tax Collector

- 1 Jesus entered Jericho and was passing through.
- 2 A man was there by the name of Zacchaeus; he was a chief tax collector and was wealthy.
- 3 He wanted to see who Jesus was, but because he was short he could not see over the crowd.
- 4 So he ran ahead and climbed a sycamore-fig tree to see him, since Jesus was coming that way.
- 5 When Jesus reached the spot, he looked up and said to him, "Zacchaeus, come down immediately. I must stay at your house today."
- 6 So he came down at once and welcomed him gladly.
- 7 All the people saw this and began to mutter, "He has gone to be the guest of a sinner."
- 8 But Zacchaeus stood up and said to the Lord, "Look, Lord! Here and now I give half of my possessions to the poor, and if I have cheated anybody out of anything, I will pay back four times the amount."
- 9 Jesus said to him, "Today salvation has come to this house, because this man, too, is a son of Abraham.
- 10 For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost."**

Jesus Raises a Dead Girl and Heals a Sick Woman

- 21** When Jesus had again crossed over by boat to the other side of the lake, a large crowd gathered around him while he was by the lake.
- 22** Then one of the synagogue leaders, named Jairus, came, and when he saw Jesus, he fell at his feet.
- 23** He pleaded earnestly with him, "My little daughter is dying. Please come and put your hands on her so that she will be healed and live."
- 24** So Jesus went with him. A large crowd followed and pressed around him.
- 35** While Jesus was still speaking, some people came from the house of Jairus, the synagogue leader. "Your daughter is dead," they said. "Why bother the teacher anymore?"
- 36** **Overhearing what they said, Jesus told him, "Don't be afraid; just believe."**
- 37** He did not let anyone follow him except Peter, James and John the brother of James.
- 38** When they came to the home of the synagogue leader, Jesus saw a commotion, with people crying and wailing loudly.
- 39** He went in and said to them, "Why all this commotion and wailing? The child is not dead but asleep."
- 40** But they laughed at him. After he put them all out, he took the child's father and mother and the disciples who were with him, and went in where the child was.
- 41** He took her by the hand and said to her, "Talitha kum!" (which means "Little girl, I say to you, get up!").
- 42** Immediately the girl stood up and began to walk around (she was twelve years old). At this they were completely astonished.

- 1 On the first day of the week, very early in the morning, the women took the spices they had prepared and went to the tomb.
- 2 They found the stone rolled away from the tomb,
- 3 but when they entered, they did not find the body of the Lord Jesus.
- 4 While they were wondering about this, suddenly two men in clothes that gleamed like lightning stood beside them.
- 5 In their fright the women bowed down with their faces to the ground, but the men said to them, "Why do you look for the living among the dead?"
- 6 He is not here; he has risen! Remember how he told you, while he was still with you in Galilee:
- 7 **'The Son of Man must be delivered over to the hands of sinners, be crucified and on the third day be raised again.'** "
