Scriptures			
Luke 4:38-44	<p>38 Now He arose from the synagogue and entered Simon's house. But Simon's wife's mother was sick with a high fever, and they made request of Him concerning her.</p> <p>39 So He stood over her and rebuked the fever, and it left her. And immediately she arose and served them.</p> <p>40 When the sun was setting, all those who had any that were sick with various diseases brought them to Him; and He laid His hands on every one of them and healed them.</p> <p>41 And demons also came out of many, crying out and saying, "You are the Christ, the Son of God!" And He, rebuking them, did not allow them to speak, for they knew that He was the Christ.</p> <p>42 Now when it was day, He departed and went into a deserted place. And the crowd sought Him and came to Him, and tried to keep Him from leaving them;</p> <p>43 but He said to them, "I must preach the kingdom of God to the other cities also, because for this purpose I have been sent."</p> <p>44 And He was preaching in the synagogues of Galilee.</p>

John 9:1-11	<p>1 After these things Jesus went over the Sea of Galilee, which is the Sea of Tiberias.</p> <p>2 Then a great multitude followed Him, because they saw His signs which He performed on those who were diseased.</p> <p>3 And Jesus went up on the mountain, and there He sat with His disciples.</p> <p>4 Now the Passover, a feast of the Jews, was near.</p> <p>5 Then Jesus lifted up His eyes, and seeing a great multitude coming toward Him, He said to Philip, "Where shall we buy bread, that these may eat?"</p> <p>6 But this He said to test him, for He Himself knew what He would do.</p> <p>7 Philip answered Him, "Two hundred denarii worth of bread is not sufficient for them, that every one of them may have a little."</p> <p>8 One of His disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, said to Him,</p> <p>9 "There is a lad here who has five barley loaves and two small fish, but what are they among so many?"</p> <p>10 Then Jesus said, "Make the people sit down." Luke 2:1-20	<p>1 And it came to pass in those days that a decree went out from Caesar Augustus that all the world should be registered.</p> <p>2 This census first took place while Quirinius was governing Syria.</p> <p>3 So all went to be registered, everyone to his own city.</p> <p>4 Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judea, to the city of David, which is called Bethlehem, because he was of the house and lineage of David,</p> <p>5 to be registered with Mary, his betrothed wife, who was with child.</p> <p>6 So it was, that while they were there, the days were completed for her to be delivered.</p> <p>7 And she brought forth her firstborn Son, and wrapped Him in swaddling cloths, and laid Him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn.</p> <p>8 Now there were in the same country shepherds living out in the fields, keeping watch over their flock by night.</p> <p>9 And behold, an angel of the Lord stood before them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were greatly afraid.</p> <p>10 Then the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid, for behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy which will be to all people.</p> <p>11 For there is born to you this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord.</p> <p>12 And this will be the sign to you: You will find a Babe wrapped in swaddling cloths, lying in a manger."</p> <p>13 And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God and saying:</p> <p>14 "Glory to God in the highest, And on earth peace, goodwill toward men!"</p> <p>15 So it was, when the angels had gone away from them into heaven, that the shepherds said to one another, "Let us now go to Bethlehem and see this thing that has come to pass, which the Lord has made known to us."</p> <p>16 And they came with haste and found Mary and Joseph, and the Babe lying in a manger.</p> <p>17 Now when they had seen Him, they made widely known the saying which was told them concerning this Child.</p> <p>18 And all those who heard it marveled at those things which were told them by the shepherds.</p> <p>19 But Mary kept all these things and pondered them in her heart.</p> <p>20 Then the shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all the things that they had heard and seen, as it was told them</p>

Scriptures			
John 2:1-11	<p>1 On the third day there was a wedding in Cana of Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there.</p> <p>2 Now both Jesus and His disciples were invited to the wedding.</p> <p>3 And when they ran out of wine, the mother of Jesus said to Him, "They have no wine."</p> <p>4 Jesus said to her, "Woman, what does your concern have to do with Me? My hour has not yet come."</p> <p>5 His mother said to the servants, "Whatever He says to you, do it."</p> <p>6 Now there were set there six waterpots of stone, according to the manner of purification of the Jews, containing twenty or thirty gallons apiece.</p> <p>7 Jesus said to them, "Fill the waterpots with water." And they filled them up to the brim.</p> <p>8 And He said to them, "Draw some out now, and take it to the master of the feast." And they took it.</p> <p>9 When the master of the feast had tasted the water that was made wine, and did not know where it came from (but the servants who had drawn the water knew), the master of the feast called the bridegroom.</p> <p>10 And he said to him, "Every man at the beginning sets out the good wine, and when the guests have well drunk, then the inferior. You have kept the good wine until now!"</p> <p>11 This beginning of signs Jesus did in Cana of Galilee, and manifested His glory; and His disciples believed in Him.</p>

Scriptures			
John 11:38-44	<p>38 Then Jesus, again groaning in Himself, came to the tomb. It was a cave, and a stone lay against it.</p> <p>39 Jesus said, "Take away the stone." Martha, the sister of him who was dead, said to Him, "Lord, by this time there is a stench, for he has been dead four days."</p> <p>40 Jesus said to her, "Did I not say to you that if you would believe you would see the glory of God?"</p> <p>41 Then they took away the stone from the place where the dead man was lying. And Jesus lifted up His eyes and said, "Father, I thank You that You have heard Me.</p> <p>42 And I know that You always hear Me, but because of the people who are standing by I said this, that they may believe that You sent Me."</p> <p>43 Now when He had said these things, He cried with a loud voice, "Lazarus, come forth!"</p> <p>44 And he who had died came out bound hand and foot with graveclothes, and his face was wrapped with a cloth. Jesus said to them, "Loose him, and let him go."</p>

Scriptures			
John 13:1-17	<p>1 Now before the feast of the Passover, when Jesus knew that His hour had come that He should depart from this world to the Father, having loved His own who were in the world, He loved them to the end.</p> <p>2 And supper being ended, the devil having already put it into the heart of Judas Iscariot, Simon's son, to betray Him,</p> <p>3 Jesus, knowing that the Father had given all things into His hands, and that He had come from God and was going to God,</p> <p>4 rose from supper and laid aside His garments, took a towel and girded Himself.</p> <p>5 After that, He poured water into a basin and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe them with the towel with which He was girded.</p> <p>6 Then He came to Simon Peter. And Peter said to Him, "Lord, are You washing my feet?"</p> <p>7 Jesus answered and said to him, "What I am doing you do not understand now, but you will know after this."</p> <p>8 Peter said to Him, "You shall never wash my feet!" Jesus answered him, "If I do not wash you, you have no part with Me."</p> <p>9 Simon Peter said to Him, "Lord, not my feet only, but also my hands and my head!"</p> <p>10 Jesus said to him, "He who is bathed needs only to wash his feet, but is completely clean; and you are clean, but not all of you."</p> <p>11 For He knew who would betray Him; therefore He said, "You are not all clean."</p> <p>12 So when He had washed their feet, taken His garments, and sat down again, He said to them, "Do you know what I have done to you?"</p> <p>13 You call me Teacher and Lord, and you say well, for so I am.</p> <p>14 If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet.</p> <p>15 For I have given you an example, that you should do as I have done to you.</p> <p>16 Most assuredly, I say to you, a servant is not greater than his master; nor is he who is sent greater than he who sent him.</p> <p>17 If you know these things, blessed are you if you do them.</p>

<p>Luke 23:44-46 Luke 24:1-6</p>	<p>44 Now it was about the sixth hour, and there was darkness over all the earth until the ninth hour. 45 Then the sun was darkened, and the veil of the temple was torn in two. 46 And when Jesus had cried out with a loud voice, He said, "Father, 'into Your hands I commit My spirit.' <p>John 20:26-27 Luke 24:13-16 John 21:9-14</p>	<p>26 And after eight days His disciples were again inside, and Thomas with them. Jesus came, the doors being shut, and stood in the midst, and said, "Peace to you!"</p> <p>27 Then He said to Thomas, "Reach your finger here, and look at My hands; and reach your hand here, and put it into My side. Do not be unbelieving, but believing."</p> <p>13 Now behold, two of them were traveling that same day to a village called Emmaus, which was seven miles from Jerusalem.</p> <p>14 And they talked together of all these things which had happened.</p> <p>15 So it was, while they conversed and reasoned, that Jesus Himself drew near and went with them.</p> <p>16 But their eyes were restrained, so that they did not know Him.</p> <p>9 Then, as soon as they had come to land, they saw a fire of coals there, and fish laid on it, and bread.</p> <p>10 Jesus said to them, "Bring some of the fish which you have just caught."</p> <p>11 Simon Peter went up and dragged the net to land, full of large fish, one hundred and fifty-three; and although there were so many, the net was not broken.</p> <p>12 Jesus said to them, "Come and eat breakfast."
